विषय :- वीरता के लिए राष्ट्रपति पुलिस पदक / पुलिस पदक हेतु प्रस्ताव भेजने के संबंध में दिशा-निर्देश।

यह अत्यंत ही दुखदायी है कि हमारे कनीय पदाधिकारी एवं पुलिसकर्मी, जो अत्यंत ही वीरता पूर्ण कार्य कर रहे हैं, हम उन्हें भी वीरता के लिए राष्ट्रपति पुलिस पदक / पुलिस पदक (PPMG/PMG) से ससमय सम्मानित नहीं करा पा रहे हैं।

इसका मुख्य कारण यह है कि हम इस हेतु त्रुटिरहित प्रस्ताव ससमय नहीं भेज पा रहे हैं। पुलिस बल के नेतृत्वकर्ता होने के नाते हमारा यह नैतिक दायित्व है कि हम समय निकालकर सभी योग्य मामलों में ससमय अच्छा एवं त्रुटिरहित प्रस्ताव भेजें।

इन प्रस्तावों को भेजने में अभी तक पाई गई त्रुटियों का मैं उल्लेख कर रहा हूँ ताकि कम से कम इनकी पुनरावृत्ति ना हो :-

1. राष्ट्रपति पुलिस पदक / पुलिस पदक प्रदान करने हेतु प्रस्ताव भारत सरकार के निर्धारित विहित प्रपत्र में नहीं रहना।
2. प्रस्ताव का विहित प्रपत्र में रहने पर भी उसके सभी कॉलम सही-राही नहीं भरा जाना।
3. प्रस्ताव भेजने में विलम्ब होने पर भी उसमें विलम्ब का कारण अंकित नहीं रहना, जबकि विहित प्रपत्र के Part-D में यह स्पष्ट उल्लेख किया गया है कि घटना के एक वर्ष बीतने के बाद प्रस्ताव भेजने पर उसमें विलम्ब का कारण अंकित किया जाना है।
4. घटना का सही First Sitrep का संलग्न नहीं किया जाना। First Sitrep का अर्थ है कि घटना के संबंध में दर्ज की गई प्रथम सूचना, जो थाना दैनिकी के रूप में हो सकता है अथवा अन्य कहीं दूरभाष / वायरलेस पर दर्ज करायी गयी सूचना या पुलिस अधीक्षक / वीरय पदाधिकारियों को भेजा गया प्रथम प्रतिवेदन हो सकता है।
5. प्रस्ताव के साथ आवश्यक अनुलग्नक यथा 1. FIR 2. Supervision Note 3. Post Mortem Report 4. Magisterial Inquest Report 5. First Sitrep 6. Medical Documents 7. Injury Report 8. Seizure List (Exhibits) 9. Integrity Certificate 10. Magisterial Enquiry 11. Details of Arms/Amn carried & fired उपलब्ध नहीं कराया जाना।
6. प्रस्ताव ससमय पुलिस मुख्यालय को उपलब्ध नहीं कराया जाना।

7. प्रस्ताव पर पुलिस मुख्यालय से कोई पृच्छा करने पर गद्दीनों उसका जवाब स्मार के बाद भी नहीं आना, जिससे प्रस्ताव का कालबाधित होना।
8. किररी घटना में, जिसमें जिला पुलिस तथा केन्द्रीय पुलिस बल साथ अभियान में भाग लेते हैं, उसमें केन्द्रीय पुलिस बलों के संबंध में तो मंतव्य ससमय उपलब्ध कराना, परन्तु जिला पुलिस का प्रस्ताव काफ़ी पिलम्ब से पुलिस मुख्यालय को उपलब्ध कराना।

सुविधा हेतु इस पत्र के साथ 1. राष्ट्रपति पुलिस पदक/पुलिस पदक प्रदान करने हेतु निर्धारित विहित प्रपत्र की प्रति 2. सही-सही शरा हुआ एक प्रपत्र की प्रति (गॉडल के रूप में) 3. अनुलग्नक उपलब्ध कराने हेतु चेक लिस्ट की प्रति एवं 4. फायरिंग डिटेल् हेतु विहित प्रपत्र संलग्न कर भेजा जा रहा है।

Sub: Instructions for recommendation for the award of President's Police Medal for Gallantry and Police Medal for Gallantry.

Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter No.11026/07/2006-PMA dated 9th May, 2006 vide which instructions for recalling recommendation for the award of president's Police Medal for Gallantry and Police Medal for Gallantry were circulated. Recently, the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India vide its judgment dated 23/09/2014, in Criminal Appeal No.1255 of 1999 titled People's Union for Civil Liberties & Anr V/s State of Maharashtra & others has issued the guidelines regarding holding of Magisterial enquiry in the case of death occurred in police firing (extract attached). The Hon'ble Supreme Court has directed that the requirements/norms must be strictly observed in all cases of death and grievous injury in police encounters by treating them as law declared under Article 141 of the Constitution of India.

2. It is therefore requested that the guidelines of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India must be strictly adhered to. A copy of Magisterial Inquiry in all cases of death and grievous injury in police encounter must be sent with the proposal. In gallantry cases, the date of birth and father's name of the recommendee is also required.

3. Keeping in view the above requirement, the prescribed Proforma has been revised. While sending the proposal for award of President's Police Medal for Gallantry/Police Medal for Gallantry, the requisite information must be sent in revised Proforma, prescribed for award of gallantry medal (copy enclosed).

4. The other instructions will remain the same as contained in this Ministry's letter No.11026/07/2006-PMA dated 9th May, 2006.

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Extract

The following requirements to be followed in the matters of investigating police encounters in the cases of death as the standard procedure for thorough, effective and independent investigation:

- (1) Whenever the police is in receipt of any intelligence or tip-off regarding criminal movements or activities pertaining to the commission of grave criminal Offence, it shall be reduced into writing in some form (preferably into base diary) or in some electronic form. Such recording need not reveal details of the suspect or the location to which the party is headed. If such intelligence or tip-off is received by a higher authority, the same may be noted in some form without revealing details of the suspect or the location.
- (2) If pursuant to the tip-off or receipt of any intelligence, as above, encounter takes place and firearm is used by the police party and as a result of that, death occurs, an FIR to that effect shall be registered and the same shall be forwarded to the court under Section 157 of the Code without any delay. While forwarding the report under Section 157 of the Code, the procedure prescribed under Section 158 of the Code shall be followed.
- (3) An independent investigation into the incident/encounter shall be conducted by the CID or police team of another police station under the supervision of a senior officer (at least a level above the head of the police party engaged in the encounter). The team concluding inquiry/investigation shall at a minimum, seek:
 - (a) To identify the victim colour photographs of the victim should be taken;
 - (b) To recover and preserve evidentiary material, including blood-stained earth hair, fibers and threads, etc., related to the death;
 - (c) To identify scene witnesses with complete names, addresses and telephone number and obtain their statements (including the statements of police personnel involved) concerning the death;
 - (d) To determine the cause, manner, location (including preparation of rough sketch of topography of the scene and, if possible, photo/video of the scene and any physical evidence) and time of death as well as any pattern or practice that may have brought about the death;

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- (e) It must be ensured that intact fingerprints of deceased are sent for chemical analysis. Any other fingerprints should be located, developed, lifted and sent for chemical analysis;
- (f) Post-mortem must be conducted by two doctors in the District Hospital, one of them, as far as possible, should be In-charge/Head of the District Hospital. Post-mortem shall be video-graphed and preserved;
- (g) Any evidence of weapons, such as guns, projectiles, bullets and cartridge cases, should be taken and preserved. Wherever applicable, tests for gunshot residue and trace metal detection should be performed.
- (h) The cause of death should be found out, whether it was natural death, accidental death, suicide or homicide.
- (4) A Magisterial inquiry under Section 176 of the Code must invariably be held in all cases of death which occur in the course of police firing and a report thereof must be sent to Judicial Magistrate having jurisdiction under Section 190 of the Code.
- (5) The involvement of NHRC is not necessary unless there is serious doubt about independent and impartial investigation. However, the information of the incident without any delay must be sent to NHRC or the State Human Rights Commission, as the case may be.
- (6) The injured criminal/victim should be provided medical aid and his/her statement recorded by the Magistrate or Medical Officer with certificate of fitness.
- (7) It should be ensured that there is no delay in sending FIR, diary entries, panchnamas, sketch, etc., to the concerned Court.
- (8) After full investigation into the incident, the report should be sent to the competent court under Section 173 of the Code. The trial, pursuant to the chargesheet submitted by the Investigating Officer, must be concluded expeditiously.
- (9) In the event of death, the next of kin of the alleged criminal/victim must be informed at the earliest.

(10) Six monthly statements of all cases where deaths have occurred in police firing must be sent to NHRC by DGPs. It must be ensured that the six monthly statements reach to NHRC by 15th day of January and July, respectively. The statements may be sent in the following format along with post mortem, inquest and, wherever available, the inquiry reports:

- (i) Date and place of occurrence.
- (ii) Police Station, District.
- (iii) Circumstances leading to deaths:

- (a) Self defence in encounter.
- (b) In the course of dispersal of unlawful assembly.
- (c) In the course of affecting arrest.

- (iv) Brief facts of the incident.
- (v) Criminal Case No.
- (vi) Investigating Agency.

- (vii) Findings of the Magisterial Inquiry/Inquiry by Senior Officers:
 - (a) Disclosing, in particular, names and designation of, police officials, if found responsible for the death; and
 - (b) Whether use of force was justified and action taken was lawful.

(11) If on the conclusion of investigation the materials/evidence having come on record show that death had occurred by use of firearm amounting to offence under the IPC, disciplinary action against such officer must be promptly initiated and he be placed under suspension.

(12) As regards compensation to be granted to the dependants of the victim who suffered death in a police encounter, the scheme provided under Section 357-A of the Code must be applied.

(13) The police officer(s) concerned must surrender his/her weapons for forensic and ballistic analysis, including any other material, as required by the investigating team, subject to the rights under Article 20 of the Constitution.

(14) An intimation about the incident must also be sent to the police officer's family and should- the family need services of a lawyer / counselling, same must be offered.

(15) No out-of-turn promotion or instant gallantry rewards shall be bestowed on the concerned officers soon after the occurrence. It must be ensured at all costs that such rewards are given/recommended only when the gallantry of the concerned officers is established beyond doubt.

(16) If the family of the victim finds that the above procedure has not been followed or there exists a pattern of abuse or lack of independent investigation or impartiality by any of the functionaries as above mentioned, it may make a complaint to the Sessions Judge having territorial jurisdiction over the place of incident. Upon such complaint being made, the concerned Sessions Judge shall look into the merits of the complaint and address the grievances raised therein.

The above guidelines will also be applicable to grievous injury cases in police encounter, as far as possible.

A BRIEF ACCOUNT OF THE GALLANT ACT:
(Not more than 400 word)

On 1/11/2017 an Intelligence Input was received regarding the presence of dreaded CPI(Maoist) Bihar Jharkhand Special Area Committee Member Motilal Soren@ Sandeep (wanted in more than fifty cases and having a REWARD of Rs 25 Lakh announced by the State of Jharkhand and Rs 20 Lakh by the State of Odisha) alongwith his Squad members near forest of Kundrijor under Jeteya Police Station. A football Tournament was being organized in Football Ground Jeteya from 1/11/17 to 2/11/17. Sandeep had formed a team comprising of some of his dasta members and villagers of Hessapi and had planned to visit the ground

with other armed members. A few days back, he had killed two locals in village Hamsada (nearby) on suspicion of being Police Informers. The reason was Encounter with security forces in village Buru Raika under Jeteya PS on 5/9/17, in which he narrowly escaped. He suspected villagers of Jeteya as Police informers. To identify informers, he had formed a team comprising of his squad members to play with locals and identify informers, whom he had plans to kill. SP Chaibasa Sh Anish Gupta received this information from his human assets and supported by technical input and without any loss of time proceeded with his bodyguards CT 1249 Sukhlal Sardar and CT 1398 Dinesh Nayak, apprised ASP (OPS) Sh Manish Raman and SDPO Kiriburu Mr Md. Taukir Alam of the intelligence and called them near Kotgarh forest to Plan and Raid for Motilal Soren@Sandeep, with available force. Time was very short as Motilal Soren could leave after carrying out his Plan to kill and create terror in the area, covered with forests and atleast 25 kms away from nearest Police Station. Sh Anish Gupta along with his Bodyguards and ASP (OPS) Sh Manish Raman, planned briefly at kotgarh and led the raiding Party and SDPO Kiriburu was heading the second party that laid ambush on direction of retreat. Keeping a larger raiding party would have exposed the team and made the whole operation futile, a small raiding party would have been completely ambushed by naxals had information leaked. In a show of highest commitment to duty, in larger public interest and in an outstanding act of bravery, Sh Anish Gupta decided to raid in a small team, without caring for his life and limb. As the raiding party led by Sh Anish Gupta reached 2 Kms before Football Ground, they dropped automatic weapons (AK 47) in the vehicle to avoid being identified (to be used had naxals fired and tried to encircle and ambush the raiding team during retreat), and started walking towards the Ground, avoiding road and through forest. It was a challenging and extremely difficult task to engage Motilal Soren in his bastion and in a Five thousand strong crowd. The presence of armed squad members in the crowd made it even more difficult for the small raiding party to engage SAC level member and apprehend him. In a show of highest level of courage, perseverance and dedication to Duty, Sh Anish Gupta, Sh Manish Raman, CT Sukhlal Sardar, CT Dinesh Kumar Nayak and CT Raju Soy penetrated the 5000 strong crowd and CT Raju Soy advanced and mingled in the crowd and identified Motilal Soren standing near the goalpost and the raiding party led by SP Chaibasa started approaching him. As Sh Anish Gupta reached next to Sandeep, he identified him and pulled out a pistol and pointed towards Sh Anish Gupta to fire, without losing time Mr Anish Gupta pulled out his official pistol and pointed at his forehead and ordered him to surrender, lest he would be fired at, simultaneously Sh Anish Gupta got hold of Sandeep's hand and grabbed his wrist to put his pistol down and took his pistol in his custody. In the meantime Sh Manish Raman ASP OPS Chaibasa covered him from behind alongwith CT Raju Soy and CT Dinesh Nayak. In the ensuing scuffle, Sandeep started shouting and called out his cadres present in the crowd to kill the raiding Party, Sh Anish Gupta then thrust his official pistol in Sandeep's mouth and ordered the crowds not to get provoked and cooperate with the raiding party. A fire would have created panic in the crowds and other Naxals present in crowd could have opened fire

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in retaliation, risking the lives of civilians. Sh Anish Gupta kept his composure, without resorting to fire and with the help of ASP (OPS) Sh Manish Raman, CT Raju Soy, CT Sukhlal Sardar and CT Dinesh Kumar Nayak swiftly took a safe position from the crowd and explained them to cooperate with POLICE, simultaneously taking him to safer side of the ground, where they could retaliate to an armed dasta, if required. In the meantime the ambush party led by SDPO Kiriburu appeared and the team led by SP Chaibasa removed Motilal Soren from the ground and started interrogating him. Upon his interrogation and leading to his confession 6 live HE bombs were recovered from the Kundrijor Forest.

In this Operation, Quick Planning, Swift Execution inspite of an imminent threat to Life and Limb and Quality of Leadership displayed by Sh Anish Gupta IPS, SP Chaibasa, Sh Manish Raman ASP (OPS) Chaibasa and CT Raju Soy is impeccable and they have taken highest degree of risk and without caring for their lives penetrated a crowd of naxal cadres and supporters to apprehend BISAC member Motilal Soren and successfully arrested him, using minimum effective force taking care of the human rights of the accused as well as ensuring safety of civilians. They deserve highest decorations. Therefore I strongly recommend their names for the award of The Police Medal for Gallantry (PMG) for their extraordinary and rare gallant act even under extremely adverse situation.
